



St. Clare's Guild

Members of St. Clare's Guild display the first canvases for Phase I of their needleworking project, for the Lectern side of the Chancel area in The Church, which will feature symbols and liturgy from the Eucharist. Phase II is the Gospel side of the Chancel, with symbols and liturgy from the Nicene Creed. The 39-piece project is designed to be stitched over several years.

The canvas on the left is for the Celebrant's chair kneeler cushion with the St. Martin's cross, acanthus leaf border and fleur-de-lis corner medallions. The canvas on the right is for the Celebrant's chair seat cushion and has the same border detail, with the Lamb of God and Resurrection banner in the center quatrefoil. Boxing strips matching the acanthus leaf borders also will be stitched.
